What's involved in a Pump Maintenance Plan?

Annual Clean

What's included:

- Check condition of control panel and all electrical elements
- Meter reading
- Check for any leaks from the pipework
- Check condition and operation of the float switches
- Check the condition of the guide rails and lifting chains
- Full, comprehensive report

What's included:

- Interim service, plus:
- Lift the pumps out of the chamber to check the oil and mechanical function
 - Clean any debris from the pumps to ensure they are functioning properly
 - Full, comprehensive report

What's included:

- Empty and clean the pump chamber
- Remove debris, build-up of fat, oil and grease
- Clean guide rails, lifting chains and pumps
- Full, comprehensive report
